

## **CORONAVIRUS MEASURES**

As an affiliated sports club of Surfing England, the UK Bodysurfing Association CIC will do their utmost to deliver their events in the safest possible way, adhering to the latest Covid 19 regulations and guidance.

### **The UK Bodysurfing Association CIC will:**

- Appoint a COVID-19 officer
- Collect information on all participants for track and trace purposes (collected at event entry).
- Ensure the First Aider has access to appropriate PPE.
- Complete all required Risk Assessments.
- Ensure any necessary consents are granted from the Department for Digital, Culture, Media and Sport (DCMS), Sport England and relevant Councils/Landowners.

### **General Guidance:**

- All government guidelines around social distancing, group sizes, face coverings, etc must be followed.
- Please regularly use hand sanitiser.
- We would encourage the wearing of a face covering indoors/in any crowded spaces and on public transport.

### **Pre-attendance symptom check for COVID-19:**

Before attending any sporting activities, all participants, officials, volunteers, and spectators must self-assess for COVID-19 symptoms: Including

- A high temperature
- A new, continuous cough
- A loss of, or change to, their sense of smell or taste

If you have one or more of these symptoms (or any other symptoms as they become advised by the NHS) you should not attend any sporting activity and must follow NHS and PHE guidance on self-isolation. People with health conditions that put them at increased risk should consider the risks of participating in group activities like sport and physical activity.

### **NHS Test and Trace:**

- When entering the competition, bodysurfers supply their name and details via online registration. This information will be provided to NHS Test and Trace services if requested.

### **Competition Area:**

- The contest site will consist of two gazebos, gazebo 1 housing the Contest Director, Judges, Tabulator and the Commentator.
- The Photographic team and Sponsors will be based in gazebo 2 but will be permitted to enter the competition area to capture content.
- The contest area will be marked with sail-flags.
