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INTRODUCTION

Please note: This is an updated Event format due to the new date announced for the contest. Entry was previously open for the earlier date which had to be postponed due to conditions, so entrants' places are automatically transferred to the new date of Saturday 22nd October. All entrants have been emailed separately. We do not anticipate that entry will reopen for this contest due to high demand, but if it does this will be communicated via social media channels.

There is fundamental information surfers, parents/guardians, supporters, sponsors, and other interested parties must be aware of for the format and delivery of the 2022 Junior Surf Series. Surfers must familiarise themselves with this document and by entering the event you have accepted the terms of this document. IMPORTANT DATES:

- **Monday 17th October at 5.00pm** – All successful entrants to the event will be confirmed and surfers who do not have places will be informed by this day. If you are booking travel/accommodation to Bude, you may wish to choose to wait for this confirmation.
- **Thursday 20th October at 1pm** – Deadline for Contest Organisers to make the Event Call – if the forecast is clear, we will make the call on the Wednesday 19th October.

Please note, whilst we are making every effort to deliver this event there are variables outside of our control that would mean we could not run, such as no appropriate Lifeguard Cover, rejections to run from the Landowner, Council Events Team, Department for Digital, Culture, Media and Sport Events team, or Sport England.



We are striving to consider everything to ensure the event runs and is safe. Should there be stormy/too large surf conditions, we may change locations.

ENTRY INFORMATION

The event will be a 1-day, single peak event with live scoring. The event will be capped and there may not be places available for everyone who wishes to compete. The organising club will hold 50% of the places and the remaining will be on a first come first serve basis.

You must be a Member of your Surfing England to enter the contest or a member of Bude WaveRiders.

At this stage it is not anticipated that the revised date will be open to any new entrants, and as described in the emails to those whose entries were accepted for the original date, that entry will be entered again for the new date UNLESS confirmed a refund is required within 7 days of receiving the email.

Therefore, the updated information required is:

- **All entries into the event will be confirmed by Monday 17th October at 5.00pm.** If you are booking travel/accommodation to Bude, you may wish to choose to wait for this confirmation.
 - A minimum of 3 Surfers will be required in a division for them to run.
 - All competitors are required to have read and agree to the terms of this document.
