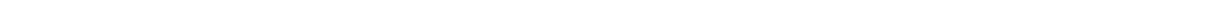

OVERVIEW

The aim of this event is to offer our English clubs an opportunity to showcase their talent in a team format. The event is a fun and inclusive competition welcoming families, adults, groms and surfers of all levels. Club champions will be crowned in each division and overall club champions will be awarded 2023 korev lager English Interclub Surfing Championship title.

TEAM SIZE/ENTRY FEES:

A team is the following structure:

- OPEN – 10 surfers consisting of any age (minimum 8) and any gender (£40 per entrant/£400 per team)
- WOMEN – 5 surfers consisting of any age (minimum 8) but only female gender (£40 per entrant/£200 per team)

Incomplete teams will be accepted, with the understanding we may merge or add people to create complete teams, with the clubs permissions.

A complete team is 15 surfers' total.

EVENT DATES: Saturday 7th – Sunday 8th October

LOCATION: The Wave, Bristol

IMPORTANT DATES:

- Monday 18th September at 10:00am – Entries open. Please find the team entry form linked here. Entries will be first come, first serve basis. We have capacity for 12 teams.
- Friday 29th September at 10:00am – Entry Closes. If the contest is full, we reserve the right to close entry early.

CONTEST FORMAT

The format will be:

- Every surfer will have 2 hours of lake time, 1 hour on the left, and 1 on the right.
- 3 different surf clubs, each with 5 surfers, will be in the water on any side at one time, so 15 surfers in the lake on each side, a total of 30 across both sides.
- Within each hour, surfers will be scored for approximately 20 minutes, on 6 sets of waves.
- A priority style board will be placed over the railing on the pier to show which colour is being scored for that set. E.g., red will be the first 6 sets, then white, then blue. To total 18 sets (an hours surfing at The Wave).
- Surfers who are being scored, i.e., red, will surf on wave 2, and must allow 3 waves between the next red scoring, so red team member 2 will take off on wave 6 next. This is to allow judges to score the whole wave.



- The spare waves between the scoring waves can be used for free surfing for other teams in the lake. One empty wave must be left in case we have to pause for wipe outs, but there are still nearly enough waves for everyone to free surf on each set. Surfers who are free surfing must be respectful to one another and share accordingly, and make sure the surfers in priority are on the right waves.
- A member of the event team will be on the wall by the take off to help assist with this.
- The team that's 'heat' is first 20 mins, middle 20 mins and last 20 mins, will be randomised – as each team will have different preferences about advantages of warming up or about being tired.
- If surfers wish to rest for a set, they can sit in the water by the side of the pier.
- Please always be courteous of the surfers who are in priority and make sure they can surf on the waves that are judged.
- Surfers will be scored on all 6 waves of their 'heat', the highest 2 scores will count.
- These points will be added into a leaderboard table.
- Open teams, women's teams, and overall club champion results will be calculated from the leaderboard.

We have full flexibility of the lake on the 5-6pm slot on Saturday, and 1-2pm slot on Sunday. Depending on numbers, we may use this hour to run on a different setting/add in another element to the contest. TBC once entry closes.

Surfing will take place on Saturday 7th October from 12pm-6pm, and on Sunday 8th October, 8am – 2pm.

JUDGING DEVELOPMENT

This event is a great way for new judges to have a go at judging at a larger competition, and also in a wave pool setting. We encourage all clubs to put forward a volunteer judge for the event, names to be included on entry form.

We hope to provide a welcoming learning space for judges with any experience level. We want judges to increase their confidence and be able to return to their home club with new skills and better practice. This aims to build local surf club development in both coaching and competition.

ENTRY INFORMATION

MEMBERSHIP:

You can enter a team for your club straight away, but you **must** have a surf club affiliation to validate your entry ahead of the competition.

ENTRY INFORMATION:

- **Monday 18th September at 10:00am** – Entries open.
- Please enter by completing the team entry form on our website here. Email your completed form to hannah@surfingengland.org.
- Every surf club will be permitted to submit a team (until we reach 12 teams). If we reach 12 team entries before the closing date, entry will be closed early.
- Entries will be accepted on a first come first serve basis, and we will prioritise A teams for as many clubs as possible. If there are spaces remaining, B teams will be accepted. Clubs can enter B teams straight away, but these will not be confirmed until after closing date, and only accepted if there is adequate space.
- Friday 29th September at 10:00am – Entry Closes. If the contest is full, we reserve the right to close entry early.
- All teams are required to have read and agree to the terms of this document.
